#### **MATTHEW 24:3-14**

**TROUBLING TRUTH:** The 9/11 terrorists didn't just happen to be Islamic; it's because they're Islamic that they attacked America.

#### I. JESUS WARNED ABOUT ISLAM.

1. Islam is a false religion (Matthew 24:11).

**INSIGHT:** The last days will be marked by tearing down truth and exalting error (Matthew 24:11).

**REALITY:** The Christian faith was changing lives and the world 600 years before Islam.

**INSIGHT:** Mohammed claimed to be a prophet called by God to restore the true faith, but he is a false prophet.

**TRUTH:** The angel's message to Mohammed denies the saving Gospel of Jesus Christ (Galatians 1:8).

**TRUTH:** The Bible declares that Islam is a false religion launched to deceive souls to hell.

2. Islam has spread primarily by violence and intimidation.

**TRUTH:** Mohammed advanced Islam through violent force and the sword.

**INSIGHT:** "Islam" means "submission to God," and conquered people either converted to Islam or were beheaded or sold into slavery.

**TRUTH:** Both Mohammed and Joseph Smith had an encounter, not with an angel from heaven but the fallen angel, Lucifer.

## II. THE FIVE BASIC BELIEFS OF ISLAM

- 1. God is one, and there is no other God but Allah.
- 2. The Qur'an alone is trustworthy as the literal word of Allah.
- 3. The greatest sin is "shirk" or worshipping anyone but Allah.

- 4. The four highest ranking prophets were given books of revelation: Moses, David, Jesus, and Mohammed.
- 5. Allah has declared a day of judgment when all will be judged and rewarded with Paradise only if their good deeds outweigh their bad.

## III. WHERE ISLAM CORRUPTS TRUTH

- 1. The nature of the true God
- 2. The origin of the prophet Jesus
- 3. The path of salvation

**TRUTH:** Jesus was the fulfillment of the sacrificial system for salvation.

**TRUTH:** The Christian message is that we are not saved by what we do but by what was done for us.

## **IV. REACHING MUSLIMS**

- 1. You matter to God.
- 2. He wants a personal relationship with you, not based on what you do but what He has done for you in Christ.
- 3. He has made the first move toward you, and He waits for you to step toward Him.
