#### **CHRISTMAS IS JOY**

1 THESSALONIANS 5:16 (NLT) "Always be joyful."

**ROMANS 15:4 (TEV)** "Everything written in the Scriptures was written to teach us, in order that we might have hope (joy) through the patience and encouragement which the Scriptures give us."

**DEFINITION:** Joy is the power from God to face anything.

**TRUTH:** Joy comes not for what you have but from knowing what can't be taken from you.

**INSIGHT:** The source of joy they had is also for us today (Romans 15:4).

QUESTION: Where do we find "joy"?

#### I. JOY IS NOW.

**INSIGHT:** If you can't find joy now, you won't find it, period (Luke 2:8-9).

**TRUTH**: Joy is not from what's around you, but from God with us in our present.

**TRUTH:** The source of joy for you is the same for me... that during ordinary days God can show up, and life becomes totally different.

### II. JOY ISN'T MADE BUT SENT (Luke 2:10-12).

**QUESTION:** How do you find joy?

**TRUTH:** Joy isn't the absence of trouble but the presence of God in your life.

**TRUTH:** Christmas Joy is always sent, and it's offered to many but experienced personally.

**TRUTH:** Joy is sent, and then joy is shared.

**TRUTH:** People need good news and will listen when it's personal.

# III. JOY IS A JOURNEY (Matthew 2:10; Psalm 30:5).

**INSIGHT:** Don't confuse joy with a quick fix.

**TRUTH:** The goal of life isn't a perpetual adrenaline rush, because joy doesn't require adrenaline (Psalm 148:13).

**INVITATION: Luke 2:34** 

**TRUTH:** Someone here thinks they're saved, but they're not because they never let go to take hold of Jesus.
