## CHRISTMAS IS FOR EVERYONE

#### LUKE 2:10, 25-34 (NLT)

**TRUTH:** Christmas is for all people and all nations.

**INSIGHT:** In salvation, God doesn't play favorites.

## I. GOD'S GOODNESS IS ON ALL PEOPLE.

POINT: Don't confuse Jesus with Santa Claus (Job 25:3; Matthew 5:45).

**INSIGHT:** The universal blessing of God is called common grace.

**TRUTH:** Everything good in your life is a gift from God (Psalm 145:9a).

**INSIGHT:** The path out of darkness is to focus on God's goodness to you in the small things of your life.

**TRUTH:** Every day, much of what we have is a gift of God which we don't deserve (Titus 3:4).

## II. GOD'S LOVE IS ON ALL PEOPLE (Psalm 145:9b, 42:8).

**TRUTH:** Unconditional love isn't unconditional approval.

#### TWO WAYS GOD SHOWS HE LOVES YOU:

- 1. His attention to the details of your life (Psalm 139:16; Matthew 10:30; Psalm 56:8)
- 2. Acting to meet needs (Luke 2:11)

**TRUTH:** We only have Christmas so there'd be a Good Friday and an Easter!

**INVITATIONAL TRUTH:** God will share heaven with all who believe, receive and bow to His Son (2 Corinthians 5:15; John 1:12; Acts 10:35 MSG).

## **PRAYER:**

"Dear God, thank You for Your goodness to me. Thank You for loving me and caring about every detail of my life.

Thank You for sharing my pain. Most of all, thank You for sending Jesus at Christmas to save me.

I believe He died on the Cross for me. I want to receive Him as my Savior. Please forgive my sins and accept me into Your family.

I want to learn to love You and trust You and follow You for the rest of my life on earth. Then I want to join You in heaven forever. AMEN!"
