## **OUR NEED FOR HOPE**

**ROMANS 15:13 (NASB)** "Now may the <u>God of hope fill</u> you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you will <u>abound in hope</u> by the power of the Holy Spirit."

**TRUTH:** Hope is one of the deepest needs of a human being.

Three names by which God reveals the God He is:

- 1. Jehovah Shalom: I am the God Who gives you peace.
- 2. Jehovah Jireh: I am the God Who provides for all your needs.
- 3. Jehovah Shammah: I am the God Who is always there.

## I. REMEMBER: GOD ALWAYS WALKS BESIDE ME.

**TRUTH:** The certainty of God's presence for all our days gives HOPE.

**INSIGHT:** The fear of abandonment is one of the great causes of hopelessness (Psalm 32:8 NLT).

## II. REJOICE: GOD ALWAYS WORKS HIS PLAN FOR ME.

**INSIGHT:** God says He is working in your life even when it makes no sense (Romans 8:28).

**INSIGHT:** Hope isn't optimism; it's not a conviction that all will end well... Hope is the certainty that a life event makes sense regardless of how it turns out.

What do we know?

- 1. ... that God causes
- 2. ... God causes all things to work together for good.

**TRUTH:** God is weaving a tapestry out of the events of our lives.

**CAVEAT:** God isn't working everything for the good of everyone.

## **INVITATION:**

Jeremiah 29:11 (NCV) "I have good plans for you, not plans to hurt you. I will give you hope and a good future."

Isaiah 46:3-5, "...listen!

I have carried you since you were born;

I have taken care of you from your birth.

Even when you are old, I will be the same.

Even when your hair has turned gray, I will take care of you.

I made you and will take care of you.

I will carry you and save you.

Can you compare me to anyone?

No one is equal to Me or like Me."

Two commitments this morning:

- 1. Embrace the presence of God in your life.
- 2. Receive from God's people.
