

GOD'S PLAN FOR PARENTS

EPHESIANS 6:1-4 (NASB)

TRUTH: Children are commanded by God regarding an act: obey your parents, and an attitude: honor your father and your mother.

What's God's plan for parents?

I. DON'T MAKE YOUR KIDS MAD (Ephesians 6:4).

How do parents do this?

- 1. Over-protection
- 2. Favoritism
- 3. Pushing achievement

INSIGHT: A parent is foolish to attach their personal self-esteem to the performance of their children.

4. Bitter words

TRUTH: Sarcasm and ridicule are emotional cruelty and just as damaging as physical abuse.

LIVE/LEARN CHILD FORMATION PATHWAY:

- 1. Criticism/condemn
- 2. Hostility/fight
- 3. Ridicule/be shy, fearful
- 4. Shame/feel guilty
- 5. Intolerance/be angry

On the other hand:

- 1. Tolerance/be patient
- 2. Encouragement/confidence
- 3. Praise/to appreciate
- 4. Fairness/justice
- 5. Secure love/to trust
- 6. Approval/enjoy himself

II. BRING KIDS UP IN THE DISCIPLINE AND INSTRUCTION OF THE LORD ON SALVATION.

INSIGHT: Children don't follow the Lord by accident.

What every child needs to know about the Lord:

- 1. God is holy.
- 2. God hates sin.
- 3. God always punishes sin.
- 4. We are all sinners and cannot stand before God.
- 5. Their sin makes peace with God impossible.
- 6. Everyone is a sinner and worthy of death in hell.
- 7. Sinners can do nothing on their own to be right with God.
- 8. The Good News of hope is Jesus Christ.
- 9. Their only hope is to put all their faith and trust for heaven in Jesus.
- 10. Our kids must come to God and ask Him to forgive them and turn from sinful living.

III. CRUCIAL LESSONS FROM PROVERBS FOR KIDS

1. Fear the Lord (Proverbs 1:7, 3:5).

TRUTH: To fear the Lord is to worship Him.

- 2. Guard your mind (Proverbs 3:3, 4:23).
- 3. Select your friends (Proverbs 1:10).

TRUTH: Your children should select friends, not be selected.

4. Control your body (Proverbs 5:22).

TRUTH: Any sex act not between a husband and wife is immorality; it is sin.

5. Watch your words (Proverbs 4:24, 10:19, 10: 21, 15:4).

TRUTH: Our children must be taught that their lives should improve the lives of others by what they say.

- 6. Pursue work (Proverbs 6:6).
- 7. Manage your money (Proverbs 3:9-10, 6:1).
- 8. Serve your neighbors (Proverbs 3:27).
